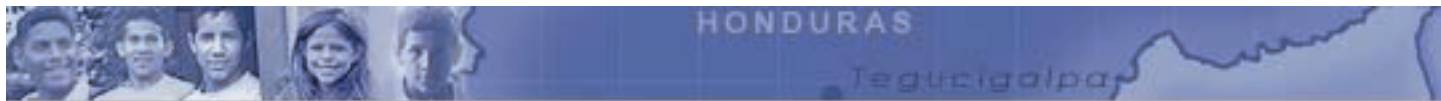


SERVANT'S HEART

Give unto you a spirit of wisdom... Eph 1:17

Wisdom is like humility, just when you think you have it you automatically don't. I have truly been seeking wisdom lately, not worldly wisdom but heavenly wisdom. *James 1:5* Says "If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives it liberally and without reproach, and it will be given."

Proverbs 2 gives us the guidelines for seeking wisdom. We have eight commands: **receive** (my words), **hide** (the word in your heart), **incline** (you ear to wisdom), **apply your heart** (to understanding), **cry after** (knowledge), **lift up** (your voice for understanding), **seek** (for knowledge), and **search** (for knowledge). If we follow this we have blessings promised to us. Verse 5 says "for you will understand the fear of the Lord and find the knowledge of God. For the Lord gives wisdom, and from His mouth comes knowledge and understanding."

I know that Nicole and I need wisdom and knowledge in our daily lives. I want all of our decisions to be made based upon spiritual wisdom and not earthly. Proverbs talks in great depth about wisdom and it's excellence and security. I pray for sound spiritual wisdom and knowledge for our lives and yours. I pray that the spirit of wisdom provide that shield that we need to protect our hearts and minds from anything that is not pure and holy. I pray that we may walk upright and in His ways that He has specially ordained & preserved for us.

We made it back safe and sound! We had a group from Alabama out at Teen Challenge making the 20 bunk beds the following week we got back. This group was very special because these guys were actually members of the Teen Challenge center in Montgomery, Alabama! They had some awesome testimonies of what the Lord is doing in their lives and they wanted to come and share their lives with the boys here in Honduras. The beds came out looking great!

We went over to visit Denia and her family in Choluteca, about three hours away. Her and all her brothers and sisters are doing great. They are planning to come spent Holy Week with us.

We are also in the process of looking for a new place to live. Although we have been blessed abundantly with this house we feel that we need to be closer to the center of town and the Teen Challenge boys.

Our church moved and is now meeting in a Hotel, Nicole preached this past Sunday, it was awesome! We are doing weekly bible classes (3 times a week) at Teen Challenge. Nicole is doing the women Bible class again in Mogote and counseling the street boys at the Micah Project twice a week.
